## Mayor's Message



Hello again South Weber Residents,

It has become necessary to adjust our water rates to meet future operation and replacement needs of the system. Zion's Public Finance has worked with city staff to provide the city with four viable options. The municipal utilities committee has narrowed their recommendation to one option. The City has posted those options on our website for your review. The City has also provided detailed information on the Rationale behind recommending one of the four options. Please take time to review the information. A public hearing will be held prior to adoption of the new rates. The new water rates will also encourage users to conserve water. Water shortage is a statewide issue, and we need to be more cognizant of how much we use.

Our Engineer, City Planner, and I met with Wasatch Front Regional Council at their Wasatch Choice Workshop. The state of Utah has been pushing for cities to build more low-income housing, affordable housing, and high residential housing. The workshop was geared toward encouraging cities to address those needs. I was relieved when the representative from the WFRC who met with our city was pleased with our general plan. The WFRC representative told us that our City was a "hidden gem". He is right. There is something very special about our community that draws good people to it—neighbors helping neighbors. I saw it last summer in the caring response to those affected by the City fire. I see it in neighborhoods when someone moves in, and all the neighbors come to lay sod. I have seen it when a burglar is spotted and neighbors network to catch the perpetrator. We have a close-knit community, and I hope we will always strive to maintain that cohesion.

## Code Enforcement Notes

While on street parking is now allowed, we would like to encourage you to not park any vehicles on the street if possible. It creates obstacles and safety hazards for both pedestrian traffic as well as vehicle traffic.

Large vehicles should not park on the streets for any period longer than 24 hours on ANY city roadway. If that vehicle is blocking or impeding the view of traffic, it can be cited and towed if necessary. Last year, there were numerous complaints about large trailers parked on the roadway. Warnings will not be issued this year, and all complaints will be directly forwarded from Code Enforcement to the Davis County Sheriff's office for a citation.

## Fire Department

We are preparing for another busy wild fire season and in doing so, hazard mitigation is our primary concern. Please let us help you make sure that your property is safe and easily protected. Feel free to call our fire marshal at 801-540-7094 to schedule a mitigation survey.

We are requiring burn permits for all agricultural burning. Contact our fire marshal at the number above. There will be no need to make any other contact as the fire department is documenting and accounting for all permits this year. There will be citations issued for not contacting the South Weber Fire Department and receiving authorization prior to any agricultural burn.

We would also like to encourage residents to notify the fire department if they are having a recreational burn. This prevents fire units from being dispatched to your home when there is no emergency. Let's have a fun and safe fire season.

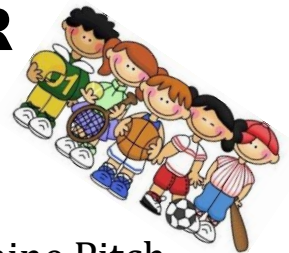
