## **Fire Department**

### **Recreational Burning**

Recreational fires are allowed as long as the fire department is notified beforehand. We will ask for your name, address, and telephone number so that we can forward that information to dispatch. Please remember that every time the Fire Department responds out to false calls, it costs the city money and can take the ambulance's availability away from real emergencies. Please help us avoid this by making us aware of any recreational fire you are planning for this summer.

### **Camp, Recreational, or Cooking Fires**

- Must be clean, dry wood
- Must be kept under 3' in diameter
- Must be kept under 2' in pile height
- Must be kept a minimum 25' from all structures and other combustibles
- Must be constantly attended by a person eighteen years of age or older
- Must have a bucket of water, hose, or other means to extinguish
- Must be used solely for cooking or recreational purposes
- Must own the property or have written permission to kindle the fire

### **Solicitors**
