General Public Comments

I have a general observation after the first trash collection with the new recycle cans.

The morning winds scattered trash (cardboard, tissues, paper, etc.) throughout the neighborhood along eastern Deer Run Drive and cul-de-sacs. It appears that the lids on the new cans flip up easily, depending on the direction of the can to the prevailing wind, and trash blows out of the cans. Because of the light weight of the can and contents, some cans actually turned on their side, spilling their contents. (see below)

A neighbor contacted me concerning this issue and he said that he had contacted "Toter", the recycle can manufacturer to see if they make a latch, similar to other cans, to keep the lid from opening. Toter informed him that they no longer make that latch for the new cans!
