

Cole Buchanan is 6 years old. His parents are Brad and Brooke Buchanan, and he has 2 brothers, Bridger and Weston (who watches over him from heaven). He loves South Weber and loves being outside and playing with all the neighbor kids. He loves South Weber Days, especially the parade, and his parents are grateful for the supportive friends and family he has here. He loves going to school and just finished Kindergarten. He especially loves riding the bus! He's a very social kid, and makes friends wherever he goes!

Cole was born with OTC deficiency and received a liver transplant when he was 3 months old. It was a very rocky road from there and he spent a lot of time in the hospital. The doctors said it was hard to tell how he would develop and grow, but they told his mom, Brooke, not to put a roof on his head.
