Mayor's Corner

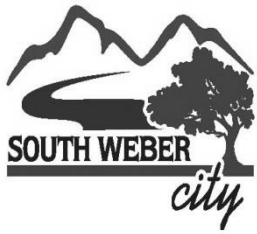
