

RESOLUTION 2020-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH WEBER CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING BUDGET AMENDMENTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2021

WHEREAS, the city adopted its budget for fiscal year 2020-2021 on June 16, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the city has received funds from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES); and

WHEREAS, the city council reviewed needs for the funds and directed staff on the priority of expenditures;

WHEREAS, the additional revenue and proposed expenditures require the budget to be opened and amended; and

WHEREAS, this legislative body held a public hearing on July 21, 2020 to take comment regarding the proposed amendments and after reviewing comments and discussing the presented changes in an open public meeting, it is in favor of amending this budget;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the council of South Weber City, Davis County, state of Utah, as follows:

Section 1. Amendment: The Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Budget shall be amended as follows:


Section 2: Repealer Clause: All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof, which are in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
