

RESOLUTION 21-44
A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH WEBER CITY COUNCIL TO
PROPOSE A RECREATION, ARTS, AND PARKS (RAP) TAX BE
PLACED ON THE BALLOT FOR THE 2021 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, South Weber City has over 33 acres of parks and green space within its borders which is only 4.7 square miles; and

WHEREAS, many of the parks are in dire need to upgraded or additional amenities for the public's benefit; and

WHEREAS, a recreation, arts, and parks tax would add 0.1% sales use tax which would be exclusively used for facilities and programs; and

WHEREAS, by placing a proposition on the ballot, the citizens would be able to decide on whether to implement such a tax; and

WHEREAS, the Council feels it would benefit the city and would like the people to choose if the parks are a priority by funding them in this manner;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of South Weber City, Davis County, State of Utah, as follows:

Section 1. Propose: Council hereby requests a proposition be added to the upcoming ballot on November 2, 2021 to state, "Shall the city of South Weber, Utah, be authorized to impose .1% sales and use tax to fund recreation, arts, and parks facilities and programs?".

Section 2: Repealer Clause: All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof, which are in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
