**A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH WEBER CITY COUNCIL
DECLARING AMBULANCE AS SURPLUS PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has been able to procure a used ambulance to serve the city’s needs; and

WHEREAS, the city has no use for the ambulance which has been replaced and the city has full ownership of the same with no liens; and

WHEREAS, Chief Procurement Officer David Larson has reviewed the department’s request and recommends declaring this vehicle as surplus to be sold per procurement policy;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of South Weber City, Davis County, State of Utah, as follows:

Section 1. Declaration: The ambulance identified below is declared surplus and shall be sold according to current city procurement policy.
