## Code Enforcement Notes

Over the last few months, South Weber has become my 2nd home and it has been great getting to know all of you. Thank you for taking the time to talk with me when you see me out in the community. While I am out in the different subdivisions, I have noticed that some of your home addresses are not visible from the street. Please take a moment out of your day to make sure that your home may be found when seconds count for our public safety departments. The following code may help you when checking your home and please keep in mind that nighttime visibility is just as important:

### 9.01.050 Premises Identification

All Premises shall have permanently attached address numbers plainly visible and legible from any public access. The numbers shall be a minimum of three inches (3”) and be a color that contrasts with the background. Any premises that are concealed from public access must post the address in a location visible from public access.

And, just a reminder from last month please keep your trees, bushes, and other plants off of the sidewalk to a height of 7 feet and at least 14 feet above the curb or street. During the winter the branches tend to be weighed down and fall below that 14 feet, if that does happen we will ask you to become compliant. Please take care of it while it's warm outside. Thank you and I look forward to meeting all of you in the near future.
